Washington State Department of Ecology Refrigerant Management Program



Do you own, operate, or service refrigeration or air conditioning equipment with 50 pounds or more of refrigerant?

If you answered yes, the refrigerant management program (RMP) requirements apply to you!

Beginning January 1, 2024, Washington owners/operators are required to conduct and report periodic leak inspections, promptly repair leaks, and keep service records on site.

This applies to ALL refrigeration and air conditioning equipment with 50 or more pounds of refrigerant with a global warming potential (GWP) greater than 150.

Equipment owners/operators must also register their equipment and submit periodic reports through the refrigeration and air conditioning management platform (RAMP) beginning:

Equipment Size Category	Effective Date
Large (1,500+ pounds of refrigerant)	January 1, 2024
Medium (200-1,499 pounds of refrigerant)	January 1, 2026
Small (50-199 pounds of refrigerant)	January 1, 2028

The largest piece of equipment at your facility determines when your facility is required to register in RAMP.
